## Israeli Violations' Activities in the occupied State of Palestine

3 October 2022

The daily report highlights the violations behind Israeli home demolitions and demolition threats in the occupied Palestinian territory, the confiscation and razing of lands, the uprooting and destruction of fruit trees, the expansion of settlements and erection of outposts, the brutality of the Israeli Occupation Army, the Israeli settlers violence against Palestinian civilians and properties, the erection of checkpoints, the construction of the Israeli segregation wall and the issuance of military orders for the various Israeli purposes.

## Violations of the Israeli Occupation Army

- Israeli soldiers fired many live rounds at Palestinian farmers and their lands east of Khan Younis, in the southern part of the Gaza Strip. The soldiers, stationed across the fence in the Sofia military base, east of the al-Fakhari town, east of Khan Younis, fired many sporadic rounds of live ammunition. The attack did not lead to casualties but forced the Palestinians to leave their lands in fear of further violations. (IMEMC 3 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers killed two Palestinians and moderately wounded one near the Al-Jalazoun refugee camp, north of Ramallah, in the central part of the occupied West Bank. Several armored military vehicles invaded the area of the Palestinian Education Ministry, near the refugee camp, before fatally shooting two young men and moderately wounding another. The Palestinians were in a car, approximately at 3:30 at dawn, heading to work when the soldiers fired many live rounds at their car, killing two and moderately wounding a third before taking them and the car to an unknown destination. The slain Palestinians have been identified as Bassel Qassem Basbous, 19, and Khaled Fadi Anbar, 21, from the Al-Jalazoun refugee camp. The wounded Palestinian, whom the soldiers also abducted, has been identified as Ra'fat Salama Habash, 19, from the nearby town of Birzeit. The two slain Palestinians were still bleeding when the soldiers detained them and refused to allow Palestinian medics to reach them. (IMEMC 3 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers abducted a young Palestinian man and attacked protesters in a village and a town near Bethlehem, south of occupied Jerusalem in the West Bank. Several army jeeps invaded the Shawawra village east of Bethlehem, searched homes, and abducted a young man, Mahmoud Issa Hamdan. The soldiers also interrogated many Palestinians while searching their homes and inspecting their ID cards. The soldiers also invaded Tuqu town, southeast of Bethlehem, and surrounded the area of the local al-Khansa' School, leading to protests. The soldiers fired a few live rounds, gas bombs, and concussion grenades at the protesters; there have been immediate reports of injuries. (IMEMC 3 October 2022)

- Israeli soldiers injured many Palestinians near the Beit Furik military roadblock, east of the northern West Bank city of Nablus. The army attacked several Palestinians near the military roadblock after the soldiers closed it and forced them away. Many Palestinians protested the attack and hurled stones at the soldiers who fired gas bombs and concussion grenades. Many Palestinians suffered the effects of tear gas inhalation (IMEMC 3 October 2022)
- Israeli soldiers injured many schoolchildren in Tuqu' town, southeast of Bethlehem, in the occupied West Bank. The Palestinians were protesting the escalating Israeli violations, including the death of Rayyan Yasser Suleiman, 7, who died on September 29, 2022, from a heart attack after Israeli soldiers chased the terrified child to his home, accusing him and his brother of throwing stones at them. The soldiers shot one child with a rubber-coated steel bullet in the thigh. Al-Badan added that the soldiers also caused many schoolchildren to suffer the effects of tear gas inhalation, cuts, and bruises. The soldiers also closed the iron gate installed at the town's northern entrance before preventing the Palestinians from entering or leaving the area. The town witnesses constant tension due to the army's daily invasions and the constant attacks by the illegal Israeli colonizers. In related news, the soldiers fired gas bombs and concussion grenades at a school in Tal village, south of the northern West Bank city of Nablus, forcing the administration to close the school and send the children home. ## Israeli Settler Violence

- Many Israeli colonizers attacked a Palestinian school in Huwwara town, south of Nablus, in the northern part of the occupied West Bank, and injured at least three children. A large group of colonizers attacked Huwwara High School For Boys after gathering near it and fired a few live rounds. The colonizers tried to invade the school before many students started throwing stones at them to force them away. (IMEMC 3 October 2022)
- The Ibrahimi Mosque in Hebron City was exposed to serious desecration last night when hundreds of Israeli settlers held and participated in a boisterous concert that involved singing, dancing and drinking alcohol at

- the Islamic holy site. The settler revelry at the Ibrahimi Mosque, which started on Sunday night, continued into the early morning hours of Monday. The Israeli occupation forces (IOF) imposed strict military measures around the Mosque and the southern area of Hebron City in order to secure the settler celebrations at the Islamic holy site. The IOF closed the Ibrahimi Mosque to Muslim worshipers and allowed buses carrying hundreds of settlers from the illegal settlements of the West Bank to enter the Old City of Hebron in order to hold celebrations at the Ibrahimi Mosque. The settler revelry involved verbal attacks on the Islamic religion, Prophet Muhammad (Peace be upon him) and the Arabs, as well as provocative dances and racist and obscene songs. - Dozens of Israeli settlers desecrated the Aqsa Mosque in Occupied Jerusalem under tight police protection in the morning and later in the afternoon. At least 214 settlers, including students of religious institutes, entered the Mosque in different groups through its Maghariba Gate and toured its courtyards under police guard, according to al-Qastal News website. During their tours at the Islamic holy site, the settlers received lectures from rabbis about the alleged temple mount and a number of them provocatively performed Talmudic prayers. One of the settlers was photographed carrying an Israeli flag in front of the main stairway that leads to the Dome of the Rock prayer building at the Aqsa Mosque. Meanwhile, the Israeli occupation police imposed movement restrictions on Muslim worshipers at the Aqsa Mosque's entrances and gates. (PALINFO 2 October 2022)
  - Six Palestinians sustained injuries in a settler attack in Huwara town, south of Nablus city. Two casualties were reported with bruises and four others suffering from tear gas suffocation. Among the casualties, there was a 17-year-old girl, who was assaulted by the settler. Meanwhile, settlers rampaged at the main street near Yitzhar colonial settlement and attacked an ambulance, pelting it with stones and smashing its windows. No injuries were reported though. (WAFA 3 October 2022)
  - Israeli settlers uprooted dozens of olive saplings in al-Khader town, south of Bethlehem city. Israeli settlers ravaged his olive grove adjacent to the settler-only by-pass Road 60, west of the town, uprooting and damaging 40 recently planted olive saplings. (WAFA 3 October 2022)

## Home Demolition & Demolition threats

- Israeli soldiers demolished an under-construction Palestinian home and two sheds in the Erfa'eyya village, east of Yatta city, south of Hebron, in the southern part of the occupied West Bank. A large military force invaded the village after surrounding it. The soldiers demolished an under-construction home and two sheds owned by Mahmoud Mahmoud Al-Amour. The home, and two other homes, received the demolition orders just a day earlier. (IMEMC 3 October 2022)
- Israeli forces today razed a Palestinian house in Khallet al-Eeda area, close to Jabal Johar, in the southern part of Hebron city. Several army jeeps and bulldozers stormed the area, where the gun-toting soldiers muscled inside the family house of Arafat al-Rajabi, and forced the eight-member family out of the 120-square-meter property. The soldiers then demolished the property purportedly for being built without a permit from the so-called "Civil Administration Office", reducing it to rubble. (WAFA 3 October 2022)

### Israeli Closures

- Israeli forces sealed off the entrance of Tuqu' town, southeast of Bethlehem. Israeli forces closed the western and northern entrances of the southern West Bank town. The gun-toting soldiers stormed the town and surrounded the area of Khirbet Ad-Deir area, triggering confrontations. The soldiers opened fire at the protesters, hitting a minor by a rubber-coated steel bullet in the thigh and causing several others to suffocate from tear gas. (WAFA 3 October 2022)
